Questions to discuss with your churches

- If you're a Christian parent, would you be equally happy for your children to be single or married? Most parents want grandchildren and are often quite vocal about it which can't help but make single people and childless couples feel second-rate.
- Do our church leadership and ministry roles equally reflect the value of single and married people, both male and female?
- Do we talk about being 'still single' as though it's a transitory phrase?
- Do we talk about our spouses as our 'other half'?
- Do we treat single people as though they're not quite grown up, don't have huge responsibilities, have lots of spare time or don't know anything about children?
- When we teach about abstinence, do we present its benefits in terms of marriage ('true love waits' it'll be better for your marriage if you've stayed pure) or do we celebrate abstinence as a reward in itself?
- Are all our celebrations in church centred around nuclear family (engagements, weddings, births, christening / dedication / baptism) or do we have ways of celebrating the single people in our church?
- Are we open about the difficulties in our marriages and do we invite single people to share their wisdom, to pray for us and to serve in our families?
- Are we willing to share lives together holidays, housing, chores, possessions even when it's inconvenient?
